Ian however even with the use of the rescue dinghy managed to go for a swim - just as well it wasn't winter.

The next Handicap race day on 07/05/06. The racing will be just as close and exciting with even more Solings competing. Hope to see you there. Also the Soling NSW State titles are coming up on 29-30 April 06 at CCRYC. It is expected that there will be more than 20 yachts competing for the title.
